WORKSHOP - DAY The Tailor's hand at work, slicing fabric, sewing and crafting the suit. VINCENT (V.O.) But no matter how fast I go... INT. APARTMENT - DAY Vincent stands by a window, overseeing the city. He holds his baby son in his arms. VINCENT (V.O.) ... there's never enough time. The baby's hands grip Vincent's suit lapel. INT. WORKSHOP - DAY The Tailor makes the final touches on a mannequin wearing the suit. VINCENT (V.O.) So all that is left... He steps back, his eyes hunting for imperfections. EXT.
